

# What's the buzz?

**We are excited to share that our new visitor management system will be in place as the new school year begins.** The new system, which requires visitors to the school to be “buzzed” into the school, is intended to enhance the safety and security of both students and staff by establishing greater door control at the primary entrance to the school.



## So, what does this mean for you and your student?

1. During normal arrival and dismissal times there will be no change.
2. Once the school day begins, our doors will be locked and visitors will need to press the bell button to gain entry to the school. (If your child arrives late to school, you must come to the office to sign in your child. Please do not drop off your child after the start of school and allow him or her to come to the locked entrance alone.)
3. Upon entering the school, visitors will follow our normal visitor procedure and sign in to receive a Visitor's Badge.
4. When visitors are ready to leave, they should exit the school building through the main entrance and officially check out.
